

PONY CLUB ASSOCIATION OF QLD

PCAQ is not involved in the running of Open Days but does not prevent clubs from doing so. Open Days are normally defined as events at which all the competitors are not pony club members. (Not to be confused with your normal pony club gymkhana etc.) However, clubs must print on the programme the competition rules, by-laws and conditions under which the Open Day will be held.

When holding Open Days, the following are considered to be minimum requirements:

- **All non-members must sign a Participation Agreement** (See Page 67)
- all riders to wear approved helmet (Equestrian type (AS/NZ 3838, EN 1384 or ASTM F1163 or better)
- all riders to wear approved boots (refer Gear Check Book)
- only approved pony club horse gear to be used (refer GearCheck book)
- spurs as per pony club rules
- events to be run to **pony club competition rules**
- organisers must not sell alcohol **during** the competition
- the organising sub-committee is to be appointed by the club/zone management committee
- visitors should sign the waiver form

PCAQ financial members will be covered by all insurances. Non-members will not be covered by any PCAQ insurance. Failure of organisers to follow the above minimum requirements may jeopardise insurance cover.
