The club reserves the right to refuse an entry with or without providing a reason.

HORSE HEALTH DECLARATIONS MUST BE HANDED IN ON ARRIVAL

RULES AND CONDITIONS:

1. Competitors ride at their own risk under the rules of PCAQ.
2. The Judge's decision is final in ALL events.
3. Disputes are to be lodged within 30 minutes of the completion of any event and must be accompanied by a \$50.00 fee.
4. The Committee reserves the right to amend the program.
5. All competitors must wear an approved helmet and be suitably attired in Pony Club Uniform.
6. All competitors ride HC if they don't hand in Performance Card.
7. Riders may enter 2 horses in same or different heights/grade/class. Each horse may gain qualifying results, Each horse will be placed in it's class and eligible for overall awards.

PCAQ Rider ID / Membership Card: From January 2006 PCAQ require that all riders produce their "PCAQ Rider ID card" on the day. (This is in addition to grading cards where applicable to the class entered) This ID number must be included on the event nomination form.
