### **Rules & Conditions**

- All horses and riders compete at own risk.
- Conducted under rules and regulations of PCAQ.
- Must be a financial PCAQ member and card to be shown at nomination.
- Completed Horse Health Declarations must be presented on arrival.
- One rider. One horse. One set of gear for the whole day. No gear to be altered throughout the day.
- Saddlery and equipment must be as per PCAQ regulations. Riding boots, safety standard helmet (ASA 3838 or better) must be worn while mounted.
- Abuse to any judge, steward, official or animal will result in immediate disqualification from the remainder of the program and is at the official's discretion.
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to change or amend the program at any time including the combining or splitting of groups.
- Complaints or disputes must be registered with official delegate. Protests must be logged in writing with a \$50 fee within one hour of event concerned. Money is non-refundable if complaint is not upheld. One senior from each club to form disputes committee. The committee's decision will be final.
- A senior club official is to be responsible for own members competing in their correct age group.
- Assisted is non-competitive and encouragement ribbons will be presented to each rider. The assisted group is designed for beginner riders who are not competent enough to ride with speed and compete against their experienced counterparts. The assisted group is aimed at allowing the kids to 'have a go' without the need for speed. Encouragement ribbons will be presented to each rider after 'having a go' and completing an event.
- Assisted: The leader is there for the safety of the rider and will lead from the shoulder of the pony & MUST be a pony club member.
- \*\*Under 8s Mystery, Rider Class and Keyhole to share event with 9 years & over.
- Ribbons to 6th place in each event (excluding non-competitive groups).
- Trophies to 4th place in each group (excluding non-competitive groups).
- Senior riders\*, non-competitive groups, and age groups of less than four riders are not eligible for highest points.
- Perpetual Trophy: Highest Points Buderim Rider
- Champion Riders - Junior and Senior will be judged at the completion of the day's events. All riders 8 and under 26 years who placed 1st in Rider Class will be eligible.
- All competitors must be in full Pony Club Uniforms for trophy presentation or NO TROPHY PRESENTED TO WINNER.
- No dogs permitted.
