- Starting Time:** **9am Saturday 20th Dressage** (Dressage Gear Check starting at 8.45 am. Dressage Pencillers also 8.45 am. please).
8 am. Sunday 21st Cross country (starting with Introductory) & **Showjumping** (starting with 60cm).
- Nominations:** **\$50.00 per Horse. Stabling & Camping available only for horses staying overnight & Hendra Vaccinated**
Microchip number must be supplied on nomination.
Hendra Vaccinated horses & unvaccinated horses will be separated in yards.
- Awards:** **Medallions** to 1st, 2nd & 3rd places, ribbons to 6th. **RUG** to winner of each class with 3 or more riders,
SADDLECLOTH to 2nd place

| | 9. SENIORS 26 Years & Over. Riders may choose which height they wish to ride on Cross Country & Showjumping from Classes 1-3. They will be required to ride before other entries for that height. Height must be noted on Nomination ie. 95cm, 1.05m or 1.10m | Test 1.2 |
| | 10. SENIORS 26 Years & Over. Riders may choose which height they wish to ride on Cross Country & Showjumping from Classes 4-6. They will be required to ride before other entries for that height. Height must be noted on Nomination ie 60cm or 80cm | Test 1.2 |

- Rules:** HORSES MUST BE HENDRA VACCINATED, only if staying on the Burpengary grounds overnight, Microchip number advised on nomination. Completed Horse Health declaration to be handed in to Office when collecting Back Number. All riders must wear BODY PROTECTORS & MEDICAL ARMBANDS on Cross Country phase. Run under PCAQ rules, open to PCAQ members only. As a condition of entry, each club must provide a fence steward or dressage penciller for every three entries (or part thereof). **Riders may enter a second competitive horse**, but if in the same Section, the second horse must compete H.C. and must be ridden second. The course is closed to all riders from 12 midnight, 7/5/17. **Competitors must be present in Full uniform to collect awards.**
