AWARDS Riders must be in full uniform at presentation to receive awards.

Ribbons: To 5th place in each class – points to 10th place.

Overall Sashes to 5th place. Rugs to the winner and prizes to 3rd in each Official Class.

Performance cards are required for classes 1,2,3,4 & 5 and must be handed to the organising committee prior to commencement of event. (before 8am)

- Riders may enter one competitive horse in the Official Programme and one competitive horse in the Unofficial Programme OR two horses in the same section, one of which must be ridden HC and must be ridden second. The horse to be ridden HC must be nominated as such on the entry form.

- Riders currently competing in a graded class cannot ride a graded horse in an unofficial section, BUT you may ride a graded horse in an unofficial class if you are not currently competing in official classes.

Ribbons: to 5th place in each class **Overall Sashes:** awarded to 5th place

Combined Training Dressage tests must be ridden without a caller.

AWARDS Riders must be in full uniform at presentation to receive awards.

Ribbons: To 5th place in each class – points to 10th place.

Overall Medallions awarded to 3rd place.

- Performance cards are required for classes 1-11 inclusive and must be handed to the organising committee prior to commencement of event. (before 8am)
- Riders may ride a maximum two horses. Riders may enter one competitive horse in the Official classes and one competitive horse in the Unofficial classes OR two horses in the same section, one of which must be ridden HC. The horse to be ridden HC must be nominated as such on the entry form and must be ridden second, if in the same class. **A rider competing on one horse in the graded/official classes may not ride another graded horse in unofficial classes below 70cm**
