### OFFICIAL PROGRAMME

**Official Classes – 1<sup>st</sup> Round Starting Heights**

**SJ 1:** 10 & under 60cms (10 & u. may choose to rider in either 10 & u. or 12 & u)

**SJ 2:** 12 & under 70cms

**SJ 3:** 12 & under 80cms

**SJ 4:** 13 & U26 70cms

**SJ 5:** 13 & U26 80cms

**SJ 6:** 13 & U26 90cms

**SJ 7:** 13 & U26 100cms

**SJ 8:** 13 & U26 110cms

**SJ 9:** 13 & U26 120cms

**SJ 10: Seniors** Choose own height **\*Senior:. Must choose from Offic Classes: 4 - 9 to**

**be eligible for overall Senior award.** If they do not choose a class/height when nominating they will be placed in 70cm class. They will ride with the Official group and be placed as if part of the group, then points will be recorded separately so as not take a place from riders under 26. Once nominated classes cannot be changed on the day

**Unofficial Classes – Ist Round Starting Heights**

**SJ 11a: Beginner Rider 12 & Under 30 - 40cm**

**SJ 11b: Beginner Rider 12 & Under 50 –60cm**

**SJ 11c: Beginner Rider 13 U Under 26 - 60cm**

**Beginner Rider Classes are for beginners ONLY...secretaries please screen nominations.**

**Two Horse Rule:** Riders may enter 2 horses in the official classes in the same or different heights; however each horse is to have only one rider throughout the competition.

\*each horse may gain a Qualifier

\*each horse will be placed in its class and is eligible for overall awards.

**Combined Groups:** Three competitive riders make a competition (no combining required). If a class has 2 or less competitive riders, the class will be combined with the class with the height above or below eg. 100cm with 90cm or eg. 1 rider in 120cm & 1 rider in 110cm both would then combine with 100cm class. Jumping of the course: eg. Where 120cm combines with 110cm, the lower height riders jump their first round at 110cm, then the course is adjusted to 120cm and these riders jump their first round. Same procedure applies for second round or jump offs.

Placings: Combined groups are treated as ONE group for the purpose of calculating results of each class & Overall awards: i.e. Penalties and time are judged equally ignoring the different height.

AWARDS: Ribbons to fifth place in each jumping competition – points to 10<sup>th</sup> place.

Ribbons to 5<sup>th</sup> Place Overall.

Prize to overall winners.

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## **Presentation will be in full club uniform.**

**Scratching:** at least 24hrs prior to commencement of event, on presentation of a certificate or report from CI within one week of the event providing organizing Secretary has been notified of scratching prior to event.)

CANTEEN: The canteen will be operating all day.

CAMPING Campers welcome, please feel free to bring tape to erect a fence, these will be asked to be kept to stall size. PLEASE LEAVE STALLS CLEAN AND GATES CLOSED THAT IS FOR ANY STALLS NEW OR OLD.

Dogs must be restrained at your camp at all times, any dog found off a lead, we will call the pound.
