RULES

This event is run under 2017 PCAQ rules. A rider may ride two horses: one in an official class and one in an unofficial class; or two in the official classes; or two in the unofficial classes. If riding two horses in an official class or two in an unofficial class, the second horse must be ridden HC if in the same class.

The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or event, combine/split any class according to the numbers nominated and the rules governing such, to transfer competitors between sections of a class, to alter the advertised times, to refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.

Disclaimer: Neither nor the Organising Committee of this event or PCAQ accepts any liability for the damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.

Each club is required to supply helpers who will be allocated on a **pro rata basis**. Please ensure your helpers know they have been nominated to help.

All official riders must present their performance cards to the office prior to the commencement of the competition.

Pending cards will not be accepted on the day and will have to ride HC.

A Horse Health Declaration must be presented to the club on each day when the back numbers are being collected. One representative from each club must hand in all health declarations when they collect the back numbers. Please ensure each rider has written their back number on their declaration and that all riders are aware who the club representative is. This will make for faster issuing of back numbers.

Declarations are available to download from the PCAQ web site.

PRIX CAPRILLI INFORMATION

A Prix Caprilli test is a combination of jumping and dressage performed simultaneously in the same arena. It is named after Captain Federico Caprilli, an Italian cavalry instructor, who is credited with inventing the forward seat. The Prix Caprilli test provides an opportunity for the horse and rider to demonstrate skills in both dressage and jumping. The tests have the same movements as might be found in lower level dressage tests, with the added requirement for horse and rider to trot and/or canter over single jumps. It is understood that in the working gaits, the horse must softly accept the bit and may show more roundness in the parts of the test separate from the jumps. The judges will judge a Prix Caprilli the same as a normal dressage test that includes technical marks for the movement, impulsion, submission and riding. The emphasis is not on the jumping style of the horse, it is on the horse's relaxation, obedience and evenness of pace.

It is a dressage test that happens to have jumps in the way and the jumps should not disrupt the standard performance expected in a dressage test. To get good marks, the horse should be obedient and move in balance with a rhythmic tempo. Jumping the fences, or trotting over the poles, should be done smoothly with a minimum of disturbance to the rhythm.

The number of jumps and their heights vary with test level: Introductory 50cm cross poles; Training 60cm and First Level 80cm.

Trot work to be done sitting or rising unless otherwise stated. The horse should be asked to change through the trot in Introductory and Training Level, in Level 1 the horse may do flying changes or change lead through the trot. The quality of the change will be evaluated. Transitions into and out of the halt may be through the walk. Test may be called. Dressage whips and spurs are allowed. (As per Dressage rules 2017) Refusals will be penalized as an error of course. Errors: 1st – 2 points, 2nd – 4 points, 3rd – elimination. 3 refusals at one jump – elimination.

Knockdowns will be penalized 2 points for each time. In the case of a knocked down rail being in the way, the judge will ring the bell for the rider to stop without penalty. After the jump is replaced, the bell will be rung again telling the rider to continue from where they stopped.

1. If required before movement, all horse/s will be shampooed, rinsed and allowed to dry, and their hooves will be picked clean of all solid material and washed with shampoo.
2. All vehicles and equipment accompanying the horse/s should be in a clean condition at the start of travel to the Southport Pony Club Grounds, Queen Street, Southport
3. The information contained in this Horse Health Declaration is True and Correct to the best of my knowledge.
4. I Agree to abide by all conditions and directions of the Organising Committee.
5. I Acknowledge that failure to comply with the above may result in refusal of entry to the venue, disqualification or other disciplinary action as decided by Southport Pony and Hack Club Disputes Committee.
6. In the event of horse movement restriction, each participant will be responsible for the care, maintenance and cost of their horse/s including feeding and watering.
