**Each class will consist of two rounds, one of which will include a task.**

JE 1	10 & Under	50cm
JE 2	11 & Under 13	60cm
JE 3	13 & Under 15	70cm
JE 4	15 & Under 17	80cm
JE 5	17 & Under 21	80cm
JE 6	21 & Under 26	80cm
JE 7	26 & Over	<i>Indicate jump height on nomination form No height nominated – 80cm</i>

## ***Conditions of Entry***

### **The whole event will be run under PCAQ Rules**

**PCAQ Rider ID / Membership Card:** From January 2006 PCAQ require that all riders produce their "PCAQ Rider ID card" on the day. (This is in addition to grading cards where applicable to the class entered) **This ID number must be included on the event nomination form.**

**Horse Health Declarations** must be handed to the Secretary when collecting Back Numbers.

**Protests:** To be lodged within 30 minutes of the results being posted, or the incident and accompanied by a \$50.00 fee which is refundable only if protest is upheld  
PCAQ rules Apply to all events.

**Code of Conduct:** PCAQ will be in effect. Bad language, excessive striking of horse, abuse or disrespect to any official will result in disqualification.

**Rules for Combined Groups** will apply if insufficient entries in a class.
