Hendra Policy: BRPC has a Hendra Vaccination Policy in place. Riders must provide proof of current Hendra Vaccination if requested by BRPC or its nominated delegate. Failure to do so will result in the horses removal from BRPC grounds.

“This will be a qualifier for the 2018 PCQ State Championships”

RULES:

- Rules for this competition will be those published in the latest PCQ Dressage and Combined Training Rulebook revised 1st January 2017.
- Dressage Tests taken from the Official PCQ Website.

- Performance Cards are required for all riders in official classes, this includes 12yrs & under riders and must be handed to organisers prior to commencement of event.
- Two Horse Rule Applies - Riders may enter a maximum of two horses. Riders may enter two horses in the same or different grades. Each horse may gain qualifying results and can be placed in its class and is eligible for overall awards.
