ENTRIES CLOSE: All nominations on www.nominate.com.au from 20 June 2018. Go to Equestrian – Pony Club – Events. Nominations close: Midnight Monday 6 August 2018.

Numbers in the event will be capped so nominate early to avoid disappointment.

HORSES: Entry is limited to horses that are currently vaccinated against Hendra virus and their vaccination protected status is able to be confirmed on the Zoetis Hendra Vaccination Register.

All competitors must be a current riding member of PCAQ or PCA

^ Seniors all do the same dressage test but choose their own jumping height, if not stated will be entered in 70 cm.

All dressage tests will be from PCAQ Dressage Tests Book Printed April 2014.

Performance cards are required for official classes 1-11 and must be handed to the organising secretary prior to the commencement of the event or you will ride HC.

Riders may enter 2 horses in the following way:

- Riders may enter two horses in the same or different grades/heights.
- Each horse may gain qualifying results.
- Each horse will be placed in its class and is eligible for overall awards.

TEAMS: Pre-nominated teams from official classes shall consist of the best 4 riders from any one club, with the best 3 scores to count. A team of 3 is competitive and may beat a team of 4. Teams may be taken from any grade or group in the Official Programme.

AWARDS:

Ribbons to 6th place in each class (points to 10th place)

Trophies to 1st to 3rd in each class

Medallions to winners of Teams section (official classes only)

BIOSECURITY & HORSE HEALTH DECLARATIONS: A horse health declaration must be completed and provided when collecting your back number. In the event of horse movement restrictions, each rider will be responsible for the care, maintenance and cost of their horse/s, including and not limited to feeding, watering and vet costs for the time of the restrictions. For your movement record - PIC number is QJBB0368.

SCRATCHING POLICY: If a horse/rider is scratched due to illness/injury a refund will NOT be forthcoming unless:

- A. The Organisers are notified BEFORE the starting time of the event; and
- B. A medical/vet certificate or chief instructor's letter is received within 7 days after the event.

DISCLAIMER: Neither the Organising Committee, nor the Brookfield Horse & Pony Club Inc., nor any officials or volunteers for the event, nor the Trustees or any user group of the Brookfield Showgrounds nor the PCAQ, accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, ground, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.

RESERVATION OF RIGHTS: The Organisers reserve the right:

- to cancel any class or event;
- to combine classes if less than 3 competitors, or to divide any class according to the numbers nominated and the rules governing splitting of groups;
- to alter the advertised times;
- to transfer competitors between sections of a class;
- to refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason.

PROTESTS: Should be lodged within 30 minutes of the results being posted, and should be accompanied by a \$50 fee which is refundable only if the protest is upheld.

CANTEEN: Full canteen facilities available on the day from 7 am.

BACK NUMBERS: Back numbers will be available from the nominations desk on the day, please bring your own back number holder or safety pins.

PARKING: All horse float parking will be on the Brookfield Recreation Reserve opposite the Showgrounds on Brookfield Road. General parking for visitors will be on Brookfield Road adjacent to the grounds.

YARDS: Pre-booking of yards is essential. If your horse requires a yard, please contact Sandy Pollitt (sandypollitt@hotmail.com) for yard allocation. \$5 per yard.

WATER: There are limited taps for water for horses in the Reserve – to avoid waiting for water, please bring your own large, filled water container.

CLEANUP: The reserve and Showgrounds are public-use grounds. All horse manure and left-over hay must be collected and removed. We would greatly appreciate your help in bringing an empty feed bag and your own manure rake to take away your horse's manure.
