8am Sunday the 20th Cross Country (starting with Introductory)
8am Sunday the 20th Show Jumping (starting with 60cm Pre-Intro)
- Nominations:** \$50 per horse rider combination - Through My Pony Club Portal at www.pcaq.asn.au
- Awards:** Medallions to 1st, 2nd, 3rd place, Ribbons to 6th.
Horseland Rug to the winner of each class (with 3 or more riders)
Prizes presented to 3rd place
- Entries Close:** Wednesday the 10th May 2018 Late Entry Fee additional \$15
- Stabling / Yards:** Yards \$10 each
Stables \$22 plus \$40 Bond (\$40 bond to be put in an envelope to be given to stable manager when stable is unlocked and will be returned when stable vacated, cleaned and inspected)
- Camping:** \$12 Unpowered

Conditions of Entry – Burpengary Pony Club One Day Event 19th and 20th May 2018

- Current Hendra vaccinated horses may stay overnight in a stable or yard. Any non-current Hendra vaccinated horses staying overnight **MUST** stay in a stable (due to the proximity of a bat colony) **Priority to Hendra Vaccinated horses**, *Microchip Number must be supplied when nominating*
- Completed Horse Health Declaration to be handed in to the office when collecting Back Numbers.
- All Riders must wear Body Protectors and Medical Armbands on the cross country phase
- Run under PCAQ Rules open to PCAQ Members only
- As a condition of entry, each club **MUST** provide a fence steward or dressage penciller for every three (3) entries or part thereof.
- Riders may enter a second competitive horse but if in the same section, the horse must compete HC and must be ridden second.
- The cross country course is closed from 12am midnight Sunday 6th May 2018.
- Competitors must compete in full pony club uniform and also to collect awards
- Disclaimer: Neither the organising committee, nor PCAQ Inc accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property whatsoever
- The Organising committee reserves the right to (a) cancel any class or event (b) to divide any class (c) to alter the advertised times (d) to refuse any entry with or without stating a reason (e) to transfer competitors between sections of a class (f) to combine classes if less than 3 competitors
- Refunds – Only before close of entries. After close of entries 10th May 2018, refunds only with receipt of a veterinary or medical certificate less a \$20 administration fee. No Refunds for nomination fee after draw is published.
- First Aid is in Attendance
- Canteen will be open for Breakfast and Lunch. If camping there are many Dinner options at Burpengary which is only a 5 min drive from the grounds.
- Points earned by Zone 26 competitors in this event contribute towards Zone champion awards in accordance with the rules set by Zone 26 and Sub Committees
- Official 12 yrs & Under riders may compete on any grade of horse provided that it is their normal pony club mount
- Microchip number must be supplied on nomination
- Stable Bond \$40. This must be put in an envelope and handed to stable manager when stable is unlocked. This will be returned when stable is vacated, cleaned and inspected by stable manager.
- Riders in classes 1 – 7 must produce performance cards to the office prior to 8.30am on day of competition unless other arrangements have been made with the organising committee.
