The Pistol Shooting Phase will commence as soon as groups have finished for the day, while the running Phase will be a race in 2 heats (Seniors & Juniors) held as soon as all of the Gymkhana events are finished while the scoring for the day is being finalised. – Rules below

***This event will only be run if time permits.**

***** The grounds beside the main arena will be utilised for all of the sporting events (Usually used for show jumping) - this surface is NOT HARD or SLIPPERY. *****

A canteen will operate throughout the day.

Triathlon Rules

*This is a simplified Tetrathlon without the Swimming phase

*The Run phase will be a foot race over approx. 800m - 1km for 13 & over & 500m for 12 & under. This run course may or may not include some small hurdles. Competitors will score points according to their final position in the race and it will NOT be a timed race.

*The Showjumping will be run in conjunction with the Gymkhana.

* The rules for the showjumping will be exactly as per the normal gymkhana showjumping event and all competitors can use their score (Penalties and Time) as part of their entry in the Triathlon. The fastest time with the lowest points will win as per the Power & Speed rules (13 & over) and A2 (12 & Under).

*The shooting will be run according to the **Tetrathlon Rules** however **Riding Boots as footwear WILL be allowed and there will only be 2 minutes practise instead of 5 in order to ensure the day is not held up.** The highest point scorer will win the shooting phase.

*1st – 10th place in each phase will be awarded 10pts (for 1st) – 1 point (for 10th). The competitor with the most points overall from the 3 Phases will be the winner. In the case of a tie the Showjumping phase will be the decider.

SHOOTING RULES:

*Each competitor will have two rounds shooting targets each with 5 shots fired consecutively and with a time limit of two minutes per each round of five (5) shots. All ten (10) shots, five (5) on each round will count towards the score of the competitor. A maximum of 1100 points can be achieved.

*Prior to the competition each competitor will have two (2) minutes not 5 minutes preparation time including unlimited practice sighting shots.

Coaching is not allowed during the competition shots but allowed during the firing of sighting/practice shots. After the sighting/practice shots no communication of any nature is allowed between the competitor and any other person.

*Competitors **13 years and over** will shoot from 10 metres - Pistols are to be held in one hand only. The other hand or arm may not be used to hold or support the pistol – the pistol hand or any part of the pistol arm. Firing will be from an erect standing position. The competitors shooting arm must be extended with the sights at eye level

*Competitors **12 years & Under** will shoot from 7 metres. The competitor must shoot from a standing position with the pistol held in both hands. The pistol must be supported entirely by the strength of the shooter. No artificial support of any kind is allowed.

The competitor's arm must be fully extended with the sights at eye level.

The shooter's non firing hand will be used to provide support for the firing hand. The support hand may contact any part of the shooting hand and wrist.

*Competitors will shoot in details dependent on the capacity of the range and at the direction of the section steward.

Dress

Competitors will be neatly dressed in the designated uniform of their club. Long trousers and enclosed shoes.

CONDITIONS:

**Must be a current member of an affiliated Pony Club.*

All riders must wear PCQ approved helmet and boots. **Full Club Uniform to be worn at Presentation and throughout the day – no uniform, no trophies – ride HC* **All events run and judged under PCQ rules*

*One horse, one rider - one rider, one horse. *Horse Health Declarations MUST be handed in with Nominations as per new DPI Rules*

***Lead group MUST be lead from the shoulder** *Points for L & S will not count in club championship points*

The Chief Steward reserves the right to warn then eliminate any rider on the basis of abuse of animals or people. All disputes must be accompanied by \$50 & handed in within 30 minutes of conclusion of the event and the decision of the Disputes Committee will be final.
