*Lead group **MUST** be lead from the shoulder.*

Judges decision is final. Any objection **must be** lodged in writing within 30 minutes of the event concerned with a \$50 objection fee. Fee will be refunded if the objection is upheld. Bad language, excessive striking or mistreatment of the horse, abuse or disrespect to the judge, pencilers or officials **WILL** result in disqualification from the event or for the rest of the day, if considered appropriate by the judge / official committee. All riders compete at their own risk and at risk to their horse and must ride to the conditions on the day. **Smoking is prohibited in the competition area and canteen area. No Dogs Allowed on the Grounds.**

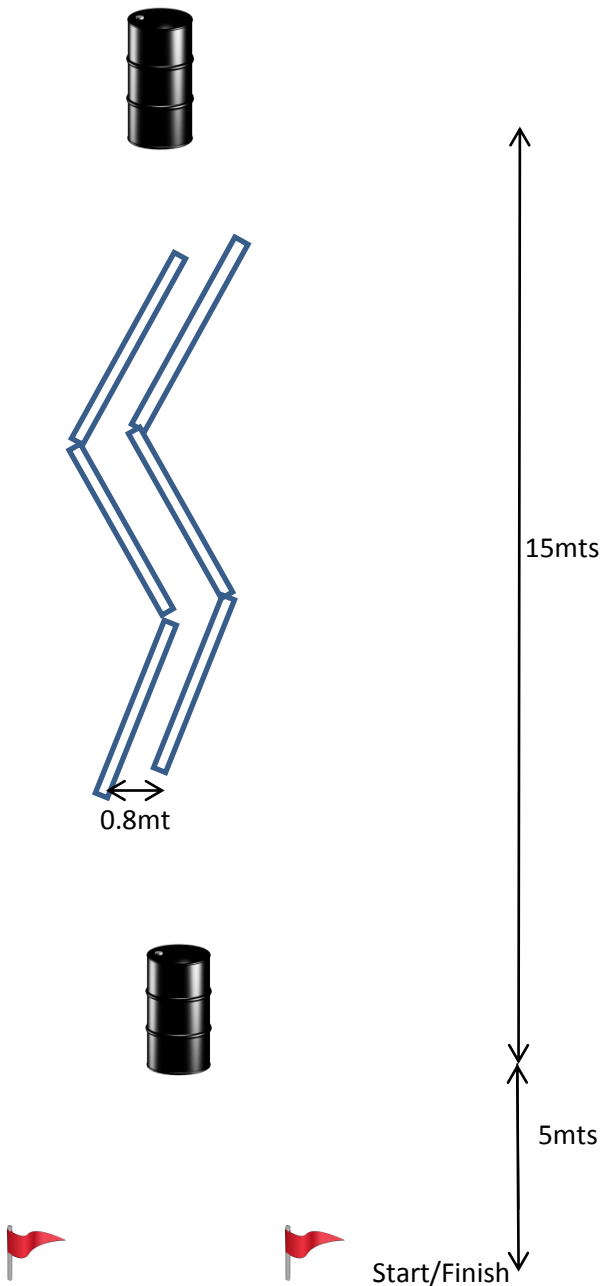

GOOMBUNGEE-HADEN GAMBLE



Objective of Game

On top of each Drum is two containers. Drum #1 has a Coin container and a Sand Container. Drum #2 has a Safe Container and Playing Card Container.

Rider starts at the Start/Finish Line, Rider must past Drum #1 on their right, when going past they collect a Coin. With Coin in hand they proceed through the maze. The rider then proceeds to Drum #2, whilst going around the drum on their right; they place the coin into the Safe and collect a Playing Card from the deck.

The rider then proceeds back through the maze, when passing the Drum #1 they must stand the Playing Card up in the Sand.

Finish through Start/Finish Pegs

Quickest Time Wins.

Rules

- If Rider knocks over a container/safe – 5 second penalty.
- If Rider knocks over a Drum – Disqualification
- If Horse stands outside Maze (Trot Poles) – Disqualification
- If Rider drops Coin or Playing Card – Disqualification
- If Coin does not go into Safe – 5 second penalty
- If Card is not standing either side or end – 5 second penalty.

Equipment Required

- 2 x 44 Drums
- 6 x Trot Poles
- 4 x 2lt Ice Cream Containers
- Coins
- Sand
- Start/Finish Pegs
