CONDITIONS –

1. Run under PCAQ rules - [Dressage & Combined Training Rules - 2018](#).
2. Horses may only compete in one grade for the day. Riders may enter a maximum of two horses. Riders may enter two horses in the same or different grades. Each horse will be placed in its Class and is eligible for overall awards.
3. Safety Helmets – AS/NZS 3838 (AU) and ARB HS 2012; PAS 015 (UK); ASTM F 1163 (USA); VGI (Europe) EN1384 – Only for helmets with manufacture date up to and including 2015
4. Scratching: If a horse/rider is scratched due to illness/injury a refund will NOT be forthcoming unless:
 - a) The Organises are notified BEFORE the starting time of the event.
 - b) A doctors/vet certificate or chief instructor's letter is received within 7 days of the event.
 - c) A 10% administration fee will be deducted from the entry nomination fee for scratchings after noms close.

DISCLAIMER: Neither the organising committee of any contest to which these rules apply, nor the PCAQ, accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, ground, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.

RESERVATION OF RIGHTS

The Organising Committee reserves the right to:

- a) cancel any class or event
- b) combine classes if less than 3 competitors
- c) divide classes according to the numbers nominated and the rules governing splitting of groups
- d) alter/change the advertised times
- e) transfer competitors between sections of a class
- f) to refuse any entry with or without stating a reason.

Biosecurity

In the event of horse movement restrictions, each participant will be responsible for the care, maintenance and cost of their horse/horses, including and not limited to feeding, watering and veterinary costs for the time of the restrictions.
