Entry Fee: \$90 per team

Camping: \$20 per camp site, must be included with entries

Stabling: \$20 per stable per night or per day

\$40 Bond per stable which will be refundable upon inspection.

BOND MUST BE INCLUDED WITH ENTRIES ON SEPARATE CHEQUE.

Canteen: Full canteen facilities available

Camping space is limited and stabling is limited to the first 80 horses (no stabling for locals) with preference given to Teams travelling from a distance

RULES

- **A team consists of 3 riders. The team can be made up from PCA financial members. (Example: club, zone or mixed) All scores to count.**
- Riders can wear either club or zone uniform.
- Entries from mixed club or zone teams must come through a club secretary.
- Any outstanding payment must be made prior to the commencement of competition.
- A rider can be in another team on a different horse in either the prep team or the same age group.
- The Prep team is an open age group team. Eg: team can be made up of a 12 and under, a 13-17 and a senior.
- Points are awarded on a descending scale from 10 to 1, i.e. 10 points for 1st, 9 points for 2nd, etc. in each ring, for each test.
- Add individual points for placings in each ring to obtain the total for the team for that test. This is repeated for the second and third test.
- The Champion Team is the team with the most points, e.g. In test 1 the scores added up to 21 points, in test 2 the scores are added up to 15 points and in the third test scores are added up to 19 points giving that team a total of 55 points.
- In the event of a tie in individual tests the average of the points available for these placings is allotted to each horse, e.g. =2nd, points 9 (for 2nd) and 8 (for 3rd) = 17, averaged = 8.5 points for each horse.
- In the event of a tie for a team in an individual test the percentages will be added together to determine the winner.
- In the event of a tie for the Champion Team Eg: 2 teams on 59 points, the percentages from the three riders in all tests will be added together. The team with the highest overall percentage will be the winning team.
- If you are unable to make a team please express an interest via email as composite teams may be formed by the organising committee.

2. All vehicles and equipment accompanying the horse/s should be in a clean condition at the start of travel to the Southport Pony Club Grounds, Queen Street, Southport
3. The information contained in this Horse Health Declaration is True and Correct to the best of my knowledge.
4. I Agree to abide by all conditions and directions of the Organising Committee.
5. I Acknowledge that failure to comply with the above may result in refusal of entry to the venue, disqualification or other disciplinary action as decided by Southport Pony and Hack Club Disputes Committee.
6. In the event of horse movement restriction, each participant will be responsible for the care, maintenance and cost of their horse/s including feeding and watering.
