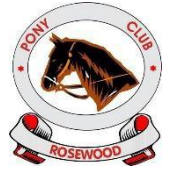


Rosewood Hack & Pony Club

Riders may enter two competitive horses in the official program in the same or different heights. Each horse may gain qualifying results.

Riders may enter two horses in the unofficial program in the same or different heights.

Each horse nominated will be placed in its class and is eligible for overall awards.

Seniors choose the height they wish to compete in from official classes, if not stated will be placed in 80cm from official classes. To be eligible for overall official awards they must choose 70cm and above and be combined in the classes for 13 yrs and under 26 yrs. If riding unofficial they will be combined in their chosen class (12/13) for awards.

Rules: Run under PCAQ rules jumping book revised January 2017 draft.

Horse Health Declaration must be presented on the day.
