Class 8	10 & under--- 60cm
Class 9	12 & under--- 70cm
Class 10	12 & under--- 80cm
Class 11	13 & over --- 70cm
Class 12	13 & over --- 80cm
Class 13	13 & over --- 90cm
Class 14	13 & over --- 100cm
Class 15	13 & over --- 110cm
Class 16	13 & over --- 120cm
Class 17	Seniors* (Seniors to state their choice of height, if none chosen, 70cm)
Class 18	Unofficial open 60cm
Class 19	12 and under 45cm, no spreads.

Conditions:

Two Horse Rule: A competitor may ride two horses in the same or different heights. Each horse is eligible to be placed in each class and for Overall awards.

10 years & under: May choose to ride in either 10 & under OR 12 & under.

Seniors: To be eligible for Overall Senior Award, Seniors choose from Class 11-16 inclusive.

Combined Groups: Where insufficient entries are received in a particular class, it will be run as per rules for Combined Groups.(See rule book)

Performance cards: Are required for All riders in class 1-16 inclusive, except Seniors. It is the riders responsibility to complete the classes nominated for the day.

Cards to be presented to the Organising Secretary before the commencement of event when collecting back numbers.

Disclaimer: *Neither the Organising Committee of this event to which these rules apply, nor PCAQ accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, ground, and spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.*

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Declaration by Owner or Person In Charge of Horse/s

I, Declare that the horse/s named above has/have been in good health, eating normally and not shown signs of illness during the last days leading up to the Southport Equitation, Official Showjumping on the 14th October 2018

I give my authorisation for the designated Steward to call for veterinary inspection of the horse/s named above and in my care should they be showing signs of illness at any time during the course of the event. I agree to pay any veterinary fees incurred as a result of this.

I AGREE TO ENSURE THAT:

1. If required before movement, all horse/s will be shampooed, rinsed and allowed to dry, and their hooves will be picked clean of all solid material and washed with shampoo.
2. All vehicles and equipment accompanying the horse/s should be in a clean condition at the start of travel to the Southport Pony Club Grounds, Queen Street, Southport
3. The information contained in this Horse Health Declaration is True and Correct to the best of my knowledge.
4. I Agree to abide by all conditions and directions of the Organising Committee.
5. I Acknowledge that failure to comply with the above may result in refusal of entry to the venue, disqualification or other disciplinary action as decided by Southport Pony and Hack Club Disputes Committee.
6. In the event of horse movement restriction, each participant will be responsible for the care, maintenance and cost of their horse/s including feeding and watering.
