Class 3	13 & under 15 yrs	70cm x 70cm
Class 4	15 & under 17 yrs	80cm x 80cm
Class 5	17 & under 21 yrs	80cm x 80cm
Class 6	21 – under 26 yrs	80cm x 80cm
Class 7	Seniors	choose own height, if none chosen 80cm

RIBBONS:	To fifth place in each round
MEDALLIONS:	To fourth place in each class.
Class Winners:	Bag of Relax Cool & Calm

There will be two jumping rounds for each rider over a different course.
This will be a qualifier for the 2018 State Jumping Equitation Championships.

CONDITIONS:

1. To be run under Pony Club rules.
2. Open to all Pony Clubs.
3. The organising committee reserves the right to alter the programme of events or Conditions if deemed necessary.
4. Two Horse Rule: Riders may enter one competitive horse in programme and one horse which must be ridden HC. The horse to be ridden HC must be nominated as such on the entry form and ridden second if in the same class.

6. Horse Health Declarations must be presented prior to competition
7. Every rider to supply a helper to assist with course changes and rail stewarding for your age group.
8. **All camp sites & day parking areas to be left free of rubbish & manure.**
9. **RESERVATION OF RIGHTS:-**

 - (a) to cancel any class or event.
