CONDITIONS –

1. Rules for this competition are in accordance with the PCAQ Showjumping Rule Book (2018).
2. Any protests MUST BE IN WRITING within 30 minutes of incident, accompanied by \$50. Only the owner, his authorised agent or the rider of the horse taking part in the competition are entitled to lodge a protest. A disputes committee will be responsible for any decisions regarding a dispute.
3. TWO HORSE RULE – Riders may enter 2 horses in the same or different height classes. Each horse may gain qualifying results. Each horse will be paced in its Class and is eligible for Overall Awards.
4. MOUNTS – the mount should be the member's normal; pony club mount and regularly ridden to Pony Club. Riders currently competing in a graded Class or Official 12 YRS & Under cannot ride a graded/Official 12 YRS & Under horse in an Unofficial Section.
5. Acceptance into this event will be refused if the required Horse Health Declaration Form clearly stating the PIC of the horses' origin is not provided upon collection on rider's competition number.

RESERVATION OF RIGHTS –

- a) To cancel any Class or Event
- b) To alter the advertised times
- c) To refuse entry, with or without stating the reason
- d) To transfer competitors between sections of a Class
- e) To combine Classes if less than 3 competitors but will jump their own heights and are placed irrespective of the grade or the height jumped

If a horse/rider is scratched due to illness/injury a refund will NOT be forthcoming unless:-

- 1. The Organising Committee is notified BEFORE the starting time of the event
- 2. A doctors/vet certificate or chief instructor's letter is received within 7 days of the event
- 3. A 10% administration fee will be deducted from the entry nomination fee

BIO-SECURITY

In the event of horse movement restrictions participants are responsible for the care, maintenance and costs of their own horses and themselves, including but not limited too feeding, bedding, veterinary costs and their own personal needs.

All horse owners and competitors should be aware that you have a bio-security obligation to take all reasonable steps to ensure that your actions do not spread a pest, disease or contaminant.

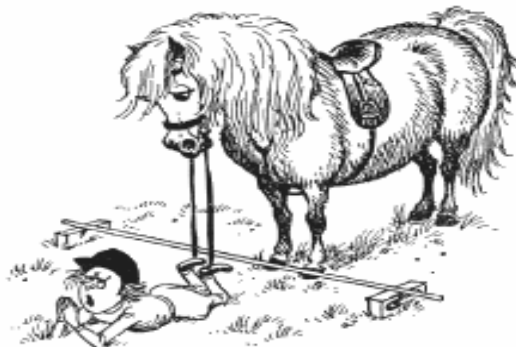
