## **The whole event will be run under PCAQ Rules**

**\*Power & Speed: Table A, 5.3 Against the Clock**

**It is the rider's responsibility to understand and follow the rules.**

**Show Jump Performance Cards** along with Horse Health Declarations must be handed to in when collecting Back Numbers.

**Seniors** can ride in any of the heights from Official & Unofficial sections. Must choose from Official Classes: 4 - 9 to be eligible for overall Senior award. If they do not choose a height/grade when nominating they will be placed in 80cm class. They will ride with the group and be placed as if part of the group, then points will be recorded separately so as not take a place from riders under 26. Once nominated, classes cannot be changed on the day.

**PCAQ Rider ID / Membership Card:** From January 2006 PCAQ require that all riders produce their "PCAQ Rider ID card" on the day if requested. (This is in addition to grading cards where applicable to the class entered) This ID number must be included on the event nomination form.

**Protests:** To be lodged within 30 minutes of the results being posted, or the incident and accompanied by a \$50.00 fee which is refundable only if protest is upheld  
PCAQ rules Apply to all events.

**Code of Conduct:** PCAQ will be in effect. Bad language, excessive striking of horse, abuse or disrespect to any official will result in disqualification.

**Rules for Combined Groups** will apply if insufficient entries in a class.  
(PCAQ Rule Book; Show Jumping; p19)

**Disclaimer:** Neither the Organizing Committee of this event nor PCAQ accepts any liability for the damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to:

- a) cancel any class or event.
- b) divide any class.
- c) alter the advertised times.
- d) refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason.
- e) transfer competitors between sections of a class.
- f) combine classes if less than 3 competitors.

**\* Showjumping:**

At the discretion of the organising committee riders may enter two horses as follows:

- Riders may enter 2 horses in the same or different heights
- Each horse may gain qualifying results
- Each horse will be placed in its class and is eligible for overall awards

**Back Numbers: Numbers not returned at end of day will be charged at  
\$45 each for replacement.**
