UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

EVENTS – same as official.

Class 11	12 & Under	45cm
Class 12	Under 26	60cm (horses without performance cards)

ALL HEIGHTS ARE STARTING HEIGHTS.

TEAMS EVENT: Teams shall consist of the best four riders from one club in the official section. A team of 3 is acceptable and may beat a team of four. Best 3 scores to count.

PRIZES FOR OFFICIAL CLASSES

Ribbons to 5th place in each class - points to 10th
Prizes for 1st place overall
Medallions to 3rd place overall
Teams Event – Trophies 1st place winners
(Best 3 scores to count)

PRIZES FOR UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Ribbons to 5th place
Prizes for 1st overall

RULES AND CONDITIONS:

1. Competitors ride at their own risk under the rules of PCAQ.
2. The Judges decision is final in all events.
3. Disputes are to be lodged within 30 minutes of the completion of any event and must be accompanied by a \$50 fee.
4. The committee reserves the right to amend the program.
5. All competitors must wear an approved helmet & be suitably attired in Pony Club uniform.

Two horse rule: A competitor may ride two horses in the same or different heights. Each horse is eligible to be placed in each class and for Overall awards.

10 years and under: May choose to ride in either 10 & under or 12 & under.

Combined groups: Where insufficient entries are received in a particular class, it will be run as per rules for Combined Groups in the rule book.

Performance Cards: Are required for ALL RIDERS in class 1-9 inclusive, except Seniors. Cards are to be presented to the organising committee before the commencement of the event.
