If you are riding the same Dressage Level in both the dressage and combined training on the same horse you will only have to ride two tests with one test counting to both your dressage class and combined training class. The test counting towards your combined training will not be allowed a caller.

### Reservation of Rights

The Organisers reserve the right:

- to cancel any class or event
- to combine classes if less than 3 competitors, or to divide any class according to the numbers nominated and the rules governing splitting of groups
- to alter the advertised times
- to transfer competitors between sections of a class
- to refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason

### RULES

- Rules for this competition will be those published in the latest PCAQ Dressage and Combined Training Rulebook Revised 1st January 2019
- Dressage Tests taken from the Official PCAQ Website - updated test book January 2019 (<http://www.pcaq.asn.au/Disciplines/DressageCombinedTraining.aspx> ).
- Horses must compete in their correct grade for Dressage as at the CLOSE OF NOMINATIONS.
- Performance cards are required for all riders in all official classes, this includes 12 years and under riders, and cards must be handed to organisers prior to commencement of event. If an official competitor cannot produce the card for any reason, any awards won for the day will be withheld until the card is sighted and the points recorded.

As at January 1, 2019 Dressage points are only counted towards grading when a score of 60% or more is achieved. Combined Training rule has not changed (ie 55% or more).

AS AT January 1, 2019 – DRESSAGE POINTS ARE AWARDED FOR THE PERCENTAGES GAINED IN EACH TEST AS FOLLOWS: ▪

- between 61% to 62.999% = 1 point ▪
- between 63% to 64.999% = 2 points ▪
- between 65% to 66.999% = 3 points ▪
- between 67% to 68.999% = 4 points ▪
- between 69% to 70.999% = 5 points ▪
- between 71% to 72.999% = 6 points ▪
- 73% and over = 7 points
- Two Horse Rule Applies: Riders may enter a maximum of two horses. Riders may enter two horses in the same or different grades. Each horse may gain qualifying results; a horse may only compete in one grade on the day. Each horse will be placed in its class and is eligible for overall awards.
- Unofficial Classes may be ridden in any PCAQ approved saddle as per the '2016 Uniform and Saddlery Rules for gear Check'
- Protests must be made to the Secretary of the event, in writing and accompanied by a deposit of \$50, not later than half an hour after the happening that gave rise to the protest. The deposit is forfeited unless the protest is upheld or it is decided that there were good and reasonable grounds for the lodging of a protest. • Members of the Appeals Committee may not take into account any unofficial advice or observations from persons who are not

members of the Appeals Committee, or anything they know beforehand of the competitors or their horses. The Appeals Committee shall comprise the Technical Delegate/Judge-in-Chief (where one is appointed), Chief Steward for the event, and Chief Dressage Judge
