The Interpacific Rally is a biennial competition between Pony Club Teams of four to five riders aged from 17 to under 26 years as at 1/01/2019, from Australia, Canada, New Zealand, USA and Hong Kong.

The host country provides horses and saddlery for all riders and the horses are allocated by ballot - this includes riders from the host country. Ideally, as well as riding ability, applicants, as representatives to their country must possess high standards of behaviour and manners, their speech and dress must be exemplary at all times and they should have a sound knowledge of their own country and the Pony Club Movement.

Nominees should be aware they **must hold a B Efficiency Certificate**, demonstrate skills in a number of disciplines and their inclusion in the Team will mean an absence from home of some weeks. Consideration should be given to the cost of being involved in the competition and whether the nominee can expect support from their Club and Zone.

All costs for this exchange are to be met by the rider. As this is an Australian Pony Club Team, the organising is done by the National body, Pony Club Australia, who will advise you of the travel and uniform costs. **PCQ will subsidise \$1000 towards costs**
