Rules & Regulations

Minimum one helper per three competitors is mandatory for each club. By nominating you are also agreeing to help or your entry will be amended to HC.

Grading Cards: ALL Official Competitors are to hand in performance cards when collecting back numbers.

Camping/Stabling: \$25 per stable/night; \$25 per campsite/night. Payable & indicated on nomination. These will be allocated and monitored.

Prizes: Ribbons to 5th place for individual tests & CT. Champion sashes/prizes for each class.

Refunds: Scratching before draw - full refund; after draw with Vet or Medical Certificate Supplied - Full Refund
Scratching after draw with NO Vet or Medical Certificate Supplied - No Refund

Bio-Security: If your horse is showing any signs of illness, do NOT bring it to the grounds. All competitors must hand in a Horse Health Declaration on morning of event.

Code of Conduct: PCAQ Code of Conduct will be in effect. Bad language, excessive striking of horse, abuse or disrespect to the judge will result in disqualification.

Protests should be lodged within 30 minutes of the results being posted, or the incident and be accompanied by a \$50- fee which is refundable only if protest is upheld.

Draw: will be posted to the club Facebook site and emailed to club representative.

Please note: Callers are not allowed in Combined Training events with the exception of class CT12.

Callers are allowed for all official and unofficial dressage classes.

Disclaimer: Neither the Organizing Committees of this event nor PCAQ accepts any liability for the damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to combine or split classes according to the numbers nominated and the rules governing spitting of groups.

Reservation of Rights: The Organisers reserve the right (a) to cancel any class or event (b) to divide any class (c) to alter the advertised times (d) to refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason (e) to transfer competitors between sections of a class (f) to combine classes if less than 3 competitors

Cancellation of Event: If for any reason the event is cancelled by the organizing committee prior to the event commencing a 100% refund will be given. If the event is cancelled during the event for any reasons out of the control of the organisers then no refund will be given.

Two horse rule: as per 2019 D&CT Rule book. Riders may enter 2 horses in the same or different classes. Each horse may gain qualifying results. Each horse will be placed in the relevant class and is eligible for overall awards.
