**Unofficial - Ribbons to 5<sup>th</sup> in each class**

- **Body protectors must be worn on the Cross-Country Course**
- **Medical arm bands must be worn on the Cross-Country Course**

- Surcingles are advised for jumping
- Performance cards are required for all official classes and must be handed to the organising secretary when collecting your back number. Nominations that do not have Horse Registration Number AND riders who do not have performance card on the day will compete Unofficial.

From 1<sup>st</sup> January 2018, the 2 competitive horse rule applies.

Riders may enter 2 horses in the following way:

Riders may enter two horses in the same or different grades/heights.

Each horse may gain qualifying results.

Each horse will be placed in its class and is eligible for overall awards.

Helmets must comply with current PCA standard (as per 2019 Gear check Rule book).

**MOBILE PHONES:** Not to be used while on horseback – in competition rider maybe eliminated

**PLEASE NOTE: Riders not abiding by the Gear Check rules in any discipline risk elimination from the class they are competing in or the entire event!**

**CROSS COUNTRY COURSE** will be open for walking approximately 5pm Saturday.

**PRE-RIDE BRIEFING** will be held just prior to walking the course.

***PLEASE BRING UHF RADIO IF YOU HAVE ONE***

**JUMP STEWARDS MEETING** will take place at Secretary's shed at 8.00am prior to cross country phase starting.

**DISCLAIMER:** Neither the organising committee of any event to which these rules apply, nor the PCAQ, accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, ground, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.

**CONDITIONS:** All events on both days run under PCQ/PCA Rules & Policies must be followed. Judges decision is final.

**RESERVATION OF RIGHTS:** The Organisers reserve the right: to cancel any class or event; to combine classes if less than 3 competitors, or to divide any class according to the numbers nominated and the rules governing splitting of groups, to alter the advertised times; to transfer competitors between sections of a class; to refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason.

**PROTESTS:** Should be lodged within 30 minutes of the results being posted, or the incident and should be accompanied by a **\$50** fee which is refundable only if the protest is upheld.

**REFUNDS:** Scratching before the Draw – Full refund, scratching after the DRAW with Vet or Medical Certificate – Full refund, Scratching after the DRAW without Vet or Medical Certificate- NO REFUND

**CANTEEN:** Open all weekend

**Camping is available and will be charged at \$5 per camp per night.**

**NO POWERED SITES AT THIS EVENT** – generators may be used at your campsite, but only during the hours of 6am – 10pm.

**DOGS** must be tethered at your campsite if brought onto the grounds with sufficient water access. At no time is your dog to be off a leash and allowed to wander freely. Dogs only to be at your camp **NEVER** in riding areas. Strictly Prohibited in Canteen Area.

**YARDS** – A limited number of yards are available for hire on a first come first served basis. Yards are for hire for \$5/yard/night plus \$10 deposit. Deposit will be refunded once yard is cleaned out before you leave.
