Rules for this competition will be those published in the 2019 PCQ Dressage & Combined Training Rulebook.

Neither the Organizing Committee, nor PCAQ, nor Gumdale Horse & Pony Club accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to any horse, owners, riders, grounds, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.

Reservation of Rights – The Organisers reserve the right:

- (a) to cancel any class or event
- (b) to divide any class
- (c) to alter the advertised times
- (d) to refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason
- (e) to transfer competitors between sections of a class
- (f) to combine classes if less than 3 competitors

Two Horse Rule - Riders may enter two horses in the same or different grades/heights. Each horse may gain qualifying results. Each horse will be placed in its class and is eligible for overall awards.

12 and under may ride graded horses but should enter only on a horse that they normally ride at Pony Club.

Callers are not permitted for the Dressage phase of the Combined Training competition with the exception of Unofficial Classes 21, 22 and 23.

Teams to consist of the best 4 scores from official classes from each Club, with the best 3 scores to count - a team of 3 is acceptable and may beat a team of 4.

Nominations must include each rider's PCQ Membership Number. Riders competing in Official Classes must hand in the Performance Card prior to the competition commencing.

Setup - Clubs are reminded that this is a Zone event and they must supply two willing workers for the working bee to be held on Saturday 2nd March. Workers to nominate online. Failure to attend this working bee will result in the club riders competing HC.

Competition Days – Clubs are to supply 1 worker for each 3 riders or part thereof on the day of the competition. Jobs will include but not limited to pencilling, gate and rail stewards and gear check.
