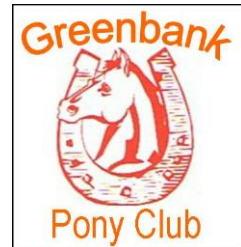

RULES

Entries maybe capped at 80 riders.

Jump Stewards:

ALL riders must provide a helper. THIS RULE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

EVERY RIDER must supply name & contact of a helper or nomination will NOT be accepted THE RIDER THEMSELVES IS NOT SATISFACTORY; as we need people for jump stewards otherwise the day cannot run.

- Run under PCQ Horse Trial rules with the exception of timing devices. No timing devices or GoPros are allowed to be used.
- First Aid in attendance
- No Jeans
- No riders to ride on grounds unless competing
- All Riders must wear approved helmet and riding boots
- Body protectors must be worn for the cross country phase (they must fit rider correctly, there is no standard with PCQ to date)
- Medical arm bands must also be worn for the cross country phase
- No stallions allowed
- No Dogs allowed on the grounds, this will be enforced.
- **One rider per horse and 2 horse per rider max but must supply a fence steward & 2nd horse is not to slow the day down so please consider this when picking the class as it is a small day.**
- Full canteen available
- Protests must be within 30 minutes of the issue and of results being **posted and accompanied by \$50 fee otherwise we will not hear your dispute.**
- Cruelty to horses will not be tolerated

CLASSES

CLASS *1a 30cm – 12 years and under Starters

CLASS *1b 30cm – 13 years & over Starters

***(CLASS 1 is a Short Course X Country – 9 jumps - riders can be seen by parent the whole way around. Riders may not compete in another class).**

CLASS 2a 50cm – 15 years and under Beginners

CLASS 2b 50cm – 16 years and over Beginners

CLASS 3a 60cm – 15 years and under Improvers

CLASS 3b 60cm – 16 years and over Improvers

CLASS 4a 80cm – 15 years and under Intermediate

CLASS 4b 80cm – 16 years and over Intermediate

CLASS 5 95cm – Open

CLASS 6 105cm – Open

Jump Stewards

ALL riders must provide a helper. THIS RULE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

EVERY RIDER must supply name & contact of a helper or nomination will NOT be accepted THE RIDER THEMSELVES IS NOT SATISFACTORY; as we need people for jump stewards otherwise the day cannot run.

We will require all cross country stewards to be assembled at the canteen area by 7.45am.

ALL GREENBANK RIDERS MUST PROVIDE A HELPER ON THE DAY & ATTEND THE SETUP THIS RULE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

- Xcountry course will be open for walking from 3pm on Saturday, 10th November and closed at 8am on Sunday, 11th November
- Xcountry Jump Stewards briefing at 7.45am
- Xcountry will start at 9am with 30cm riders, followed by the 1.05m riders & then down in height
- Showjumping to start at 8.00 am with 30cm riders followed directly by class 2 upwards
- 30cm Showjumping course will be open for walking 7.45am.

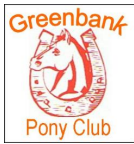
General:

- **Run under PCQ Horse Trial rules with the exception of timing devices. No timing devices or GoPros are allowed to be used.**
- **Refunds prior to the close of entries will be less \$5 processing fee.**
- **No refund after close of entries unless medical/vet certificate provided. Refund will be less \$10 processing fee.**

BIOSECURITY FACT SHEET



We take biosecurity seriously and have measures in place to mitigate the risk of infections, diseases and pests.

OUR BIOSECURITY POLICY

All horse owners and competitors should be aware that you have a biosecurity obligation to take all reasonable steps to ensure your activities do not spread a pest, disease or contaminant.

Competitors are asked to ensure good biosecurity practices at home and at the event and to follow the instructions of the organising committee and the Biosecurity Manager or risk expulsion from the event.

All horses entering grounds must be from a property actively practising good biosecurity principles within their management.

Horse Health Declarations (HHD) are a mandatory requirement for all events. Please read the HHD form and ensure:

Your horses are shampooed, rinsed and allowed to dry, and their hooves are picked clean of all solid material and washed with shampoo

Your vehicles and equipment accompanying the horses are cleaned to remove all solid material that could contain disease agents, and then disinfected.

Acceptance into the event will be refused if the required HHD is not presented at point of entry or designated registration point, as advised by the organising committee.

The property identification code (PIC) of the horse's origin must be included on the HHD.

Other biosecurity and workplace health and safety measures that aim to provide the safest environment for horses, competitors, volunteers and visitors include:

- No horses or dogs with signs of illness are to be brought onto the grounds
- No communal horse water troughs are available at this event
- Do not share equipment, including food and water containers, between horses.
- Competitors are responsible for cleaning up manure from yards and placing it in designated areas. Please use your own rake/shovels
- Competitors are required to advise the event organisers immediately if a horse is sick. Stop all non-essential contact with the sick horse. Do not allow children to have close contact with the sick horse.
- Everyone handling horses should wash or sanitise hands between contacting different horses.

OUR BIOSECURITY PLAN

Our event biosecurity plan is a set of preventative control measures and actions aimed at reducing the risk of infectious diseases and pests on and off the venue, and between horses at the venue.

WHAT TO EXPECT IN THE UNLIKELY EVENT OF A BIOSECURITY INCIDENT

In the unlikely event of a biosecurity incident, the Biosecurity Manager and the organizing committee will implement our event biosecurity plan.

You will be notified about the incident and expected to follow the directions given by the organising committee.

Everyone will be expected to remain at the venue until cleared to leave by the organising committee and Biosecurity Manager.

In the event of horse movement restrictions participants are responsible for the care, maintenance and cost of their horses and themselves, including feeding, bedding, vets and personal needs.

If a horse is confirmed to have an infectious diseases the owner/ lessee will be responsible for all vet cost and if venue is locked down and quarantined will be responsible for all cost associated with this.

Horse Sports are a Dangerous Activity

I, the undersigned, in consideration for being permitted to participate in any way in horse sport activities and in particular this event, acknowledge and accept that:

- Horse sports are a dangerous recreational activity and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially if frightened or hurt.
- There is a significant risk that serious injury or death may result from horse sport activities and in particular this event and freely assume all such risks, even if arising from the negligence of PCAQ and/or the event organiser / official.
- I voluntarily participate at my own risk and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse sport activities.
- I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during the activity and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption.
- I agree to follow the directions of any event organiser or official and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction of any organiser or official can result in the cancellation of my participation in the event and my immediate removal from my horse no matter where that may occur. I further agree to abide by the Rules and Conditions of this show and the official Rule Book of the Pony Club Association of Queensland. I understand that any such non-compliance may result in injury, death and/or permanent disability and I agree to indemnify PCAQ against all claims made by any person as a result of my failure to comply.
- I agree to wear a helmet at all times whilst riding and agree that I am solely responsible for ensuring that I wear a suitable helmet at all times while riding and take sole responsibility for my actions.
- I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby release and hold harmless and agree not to sue the proprietors of the Pony Club Association of Queensland and/or the event organiser, their officers, officials, volunteers, coaches, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, state bodies, affiliated clubs and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the activities [all of whom are referred to as "Releasees"] with respect to any and all injury, disability, death, or loss or damage to person or property, whether caused by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise.
