CLASS 7: 13 YRS TO U26	1.1(ii) & 1.1(iv)
CLASS 8: SENIORS: choose from either class 3, 4 or 5, if not stated will ride Preliminary (CLASS 3).	

RULES

Run under PCAQ rules. Horses may only compete in one grade for the day. Riders may enter a maximum of two horses, one in an unofficial class and the other in an official class. If riding two horses in an official class or two in an unofficial class one must be ridden HC. The competitive horse must be ridden first. Graded horses: A rider competing on one horse in a graded/official class may not ride another graded/official horse in an unofficial class. The organising committee reserves the right to combine or split classes according to the numbers nominated and the rules governing splitting groups. No bad language, inappropriate behaviour or abuse of horses will be tolerated. The 3 full hits rule will apply to the discipline of horses. Riders who disobey this rule will be disqualified from the entire dressage day. PCAQ standard footwear & head protection must be worn. Helmets must comply with PCAQ rules. All riders must pass a gear check prior to the beginning of each test. **NO DOGS PERMITTED ON THE GROUNDS.**

Callers will be allowed for all classes. **PERFORMANCE CARDS:** to be submitted from 7.30am for horses in classes 3-5.

DISCLAIMER:

Neither the organising committee of this event nor PCAQ accepts any liability or responsibility for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property what so ever.

PROTESTS: must be submitted within 30 minutes of the incident occurring and a \$50 fee will apply (refunded if protest is upheld).
