## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- All Events are run under the current PCAQ rules.
- Protests must be in writing to the Club Secretary accompanied by \$50 within 30minutes of results being posted on wall.
- NO DOGS ALLOWED, this is a Council By-Law and is strictly adhered to.
- Riders will be allowed one competitive horse in each section (Official or Unofficial) or 2 horses in either section, one of which must be ridden HC. If rider has a competitive and a HC horse in the same class the HC horse must be ridden last. Must be stated on Nomination Form which horse is HC.
- Graded horses will be permitted in Unofficial classes but will not be allowed in classes under 80cm.
- Performance Cards must be handed into the office when collecting back numbers.
- HORSE HEALTH DECLARATION must be handed in when collecting back numbers.
- STEWARDS, all clubs are asked to help on the day of competition and must nominate one helper per three riders.
- Yards are available on the day at a cost of \$5 per yard, please state on nomination form if yards are required and the money to be paid with your nominations.
