- Class 3** – 13 years to under 15 years (70cm)
- Class 4** – 15 years to under 17 years (80cm)
- Class 5** – 17 years to under 21 years (90cm)
- Class 6** – 21 years to under 26 years (90cm)
- Class 7** – Seniors (choose height class or ride class 4)

Ribbons to 6th place. Perpetual Trophy & Replica for winner of each age group excluding seniors. Silver & Bronze Medallions for 2nd & 3rd place in each age group. Perpetual Trophy, Replica & Sash for Highest Overall Score, Sash for runner up.

COMPETITION INFORMATION



NO DOGS ALLOWED ANYWHERE ON THE GROUNDS

Rules for this competition will be those published in the latest PCAQ Showjumping & PCAQ Jumping Equitation Rulebook.

Riders may compete on two horses, one in the Official Showjumping Program and one in the Unofficial Showjumping Programme. If they choose to ride two horses in the one competition the horse ridden second must be ridden HC. Riders in Official Classes and also in Unofficial Classes on graded horses may ride in the highest unofficial showjumping class. Riders who do not compete in graded classes may ride a graded horse in unofficial classes. Official 10 years & under and 12 years & under riders may ride graded horses, but should enter only on a horse that they normally ride at Pony Club, and may choose either 10yrs & Under or 12yrs & Under.

Pony & Galloway Competition – Only small horses aged 4 years or more whose height at the withers does not exceed 15 hands may compete in this event.

Nominations must include each rider's PCAQ Membership Number. Riders competing in Official Classes must hand in the Performance Card prior to the competition commencing.

When less than 3 competitors in a class, that class becomes unofficial & points do not count for team or official awards, and the number of trophies to placegetters is at the discretion of the organizers. Combining of groups will occur as per November PCAQ Minutes

Neither the Organising Committee, nor PCAQ, nor Moggill Pony Club accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to any horse,

owners, riders, grounds, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever

RESERVATION OF RIGHTS – The Organisers reserve the right

- a. To cancel any class or event
- b. To divide any class
- c. To alter the advertised times
- d. To refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason
- e. To transfer competitors between sections of a class
- f. To combine classes if less than 3 competitors

PROTESTS – Must be in writing within 30 minutes of incident, accompanied by \$50. Only the owner, his authorised agent, or the rider of the horse taking part in the competition is entitled to lodge a protest. Disputes committee to consist of PCAQ Steward, Chief Steward and One Judge.

WORKERS – Setup: Clubs are reminded that this is a Zone event and they must supply two willing workers for the working bee to be held at 7:00 a.m. on Saturday 10 March. Failure to attend this working bee will result in the club riders competing HC. **Competition Days:** Clubs are to supply 1 worker for each 3 riders or part thereof on the day of the competition. On the Equitation Competition Day, each club must include 1 penciller knowledgeable with Jumping Equitation symbols in their required 1 worker for each 3 riders or part thereof. Clubs must be willing to help convert courses during the competition.
