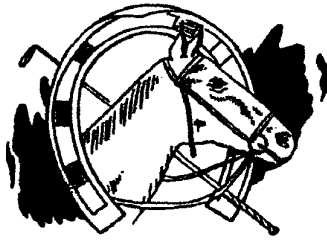

### **HEIGHT AND WIDTH**

50cm (20")

Class B	11 years and under 13 years	60cm (24")
Class C	13 years and under 15 years	70cm (28")
Class D	15 years and under 17 years	80cm (32")
Class E	17 years and under 21 years	90cm (36")
Class F	21 years and under 26 years	90cm (36")
Class G	Seniors can choose any of the heights above or if none stated, then 80cm.	

**AWARDS:** Ribbons to 5<sup>th</sup> place in each event - points to 10<sup>th</sup> place.  
Medallions to 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each age group.

**OFFICIAL SHOWJUMPING PROGRAM – NOM FEE: \$20 per class**

Class 1	D Grade
Class 2	C Grade
Class 3	A/B Grade
Class 4	12 & Under (10 & Under can nominate in this class if they so choose)
Class 5	10 & Under
Class 6	Pony and Galloway

All of the above will consist of an AM5, Power and Speed and Grand Prix round. Power and Speed judged under rule 74 2.2 and Grand Prix judged under Rule 73 3.1.

**12 years and under riders** may ride graded or ungraded horses, but should enter only on a horse that they would normally ride at pony club. No performance card is required. **Riders in Grades A, B, C, D and Pony and Galloway** must be 13 years of age or over. **Pony and Galloways** must not exceed 15 hands. Riders may choose either Pony and Galloway or a graded class but not compete in both at the same fixture. If insufficient entries P&G may be combined with D Grade but scored separately and must stop at 1.10m. **10 years and under starting height is 60cm, max. 80cm.** **Showjumping Performance cards for A < B < C and D Grades and Pony and Galloway are to be presented to the Secretary before 7.30am.**

**PERFORMANCE CARDS MUST BE PRESENTED ON THE DAY OR YOU WILL RIDE HC**

**UNOFFICIAL HEIGHT CLASSES – NOM FEE: \$15 per class**

Class 7	(450mm height)
Class 8	(600mm height)
Class 9	(800mm height)
Class 10	(900mm - 1m height)
Class 11	Seniors (Seniors can choose to ride in any of the heights from Official and Unofficial sections)

All of the above classes will consist of an AM5, Power and Speed and Grand Prix.

**Ribbons to 5<sup>th</sup> place.**

**Prizes for 1st place overall in unofficial classes.**

**NOTE:** Riders may nominate for only one unofficial height class to compete for a ribbon. However, riders may nominate a second horse in unofficial height classes and ride HC. Riders may enter one competitive horse in the Official program and one competitive horse in the unofficial height classes, or two in the same section, one of which must be ridden HC. The horse to be ridden HC must be nominated as such on the nomination form, however the official horse must be ridden before the HC horse is ridden if in the same class. Riders competing in graded section can not ride a graded horse in the unofficial section under 80cm

**TEAMS EVENT:** Teams shall consist of the best four riders from one club in the official

section. A team of 3 is acceptable and may beat a team of four. Best 3 scores to count.

**The organizers reserve the right:**

- a) to cancel any class or event
- b) to divide any class
- c) to alter the advertised times
- d) to refuse entry, with or without stating the reason.
- e) to transfer competitors between sections of a class
- f) to combine classes if less than 3 competitors

"Combined Groups" where there are only one or two riders in a group they will be combined with the group below but will jump their own heights e.g. A/B with C; or C with D; P&G with D, and placed as though they were part of the group without taking placings away from those in the group, just as we do with Seniors.
