The organizing committee reserves the right to combine or split classes according to the numbers nominated and the rules governing splitting of groups. **Seniors can choose their own height and if no height is nominated, then the height will be set at 70 -80 cm.**

AWARDS: Official / Unofficial - Ribbons to 5th place Trophies to 3rd Overall.

Height Classes:

1. Riders competing in a graded class cannot ride a graded horse in 80cm or below.
2. 12 & under riders may ride a graded or ungraded horse, but should enter only a horse that they would normally ride at Pony Club. No Performance card required.
3. Riders in Grades AB, C.D and Pony & Galloway must be 13yrs of age or over.
4. Ponies and Galloways must not exceed 15hh.
5. Riders may ride Two horses one Official & one Unofficial, or both in official classes but one must be ridden HC.

Performance Cards: These are to be presented to the Club Secretary before **8am. PCAQ ID membership cards also need to be presented on the day**

Refunds: Will only be made on receipt of Doctors or Veterinary Certificate or Club Chief Instructor's Report within one week of competition. Scratchings must be notified before start of Competition.
