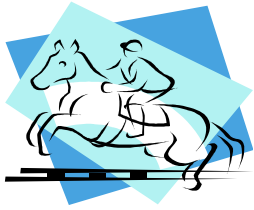

Seniors choose the height/grade they wish to compete in - please state on nomination form

Awards Ribbons - to 5th place for each Class.

Overall medallions for first to third in each class

There will be two (2) rounds each with a task.

RULES & CONDITIONS

- Horses must be 4 years of age or older.
- All events are run under current PCAQ Showjumping Rules 2012 & 2012 PCAQ Rules for Equitation, including rules for uniform and gear
- Riders 10 Years & Under may enter either the 10 & Under Class or the 12 & Under Class
- Riders may enter one competitive horse in the official program and one competitive horse in unofficial program, or two horses in the same section, one of which must be ridden HC. A H/C horses must be ridden second.
- Helmets AS/NS 3838, EN 1384, ASTM 1384 or better must be worn.
- RESERVATION OF RIGHT The Organisers reserve the right:
 - (a) to cancel any class or event.
 - (b) to divide any class.
 - (c) to alter the advertised times.
 - (d) to refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason.
 - (e) to transfer competitors between sections of a class.
 - (f) to combine classes if less than 3 competitors.
- "Combined Groups" where there are only one or two riders in a group they will be combined with the group below but will jump their own heights e.g. A/B with C; or C with D; P&G with D, and placed as though they were part of the group without taking placings away from those in the group, just as we do with Seniors.
COMBINED GROUPS: All riders walk the course together
Lower group jump 1st round;
Obstacles are raised; Higher group jump their 1st round;
Lower group do Jump-off;
Jump-off obstacles raised; Higher group do their Jump-off.
Place group with biggest number AND THEN see where the smaller group place as though they are part of the group but not displacing any rider in the primary group. The other groups are only placed in relation to the primary group not to each other.
- All competitors to be in full uniform for presentations.
- All graded horses **must compete at current grading shown on their card** (for show jump)
- Riders if they are competing in official classes cannot ride a graded horse in class 9
- Seniors (Class 9) nominate which height they wish to jump. If height is not nominated the rider must participate in the 70cm class (Class 8) – Show Jump.

DISPUTES

Complaints are to be lodged with the Secretary, in writing, accompanied by \$50.00 within 30 minutes of the results being posted.

CAMPING & YARDS

Camping \$10 per family per night. Includes One Horse Yard.
Additional Yards \$5/Horse/Night

CANTEEN

The canteen will be operating during the scheduled program only.
