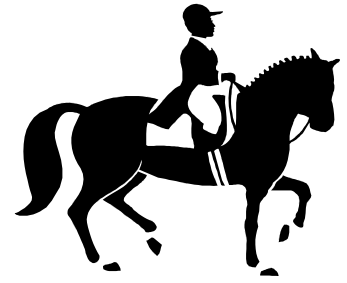

RULES & CONDITIONS

- All events are run under current PCAQ Dressage and Combined Training Rules 2012, including rules for uniform and gear
- Riders may ride a maximum of two horses however they **can only nominate one competitive horse. Only one rider per horse is permitted.** H/C horses must be ridden second.
- Helmets AS/NS 3838, EN 1384, ASTMF 1384 or better must be worn.
- All Senior competitors to abide by Pony Club rules and dress.
- RESERVATION OF RIGHT The Organisers reserve the right:
 - (a) to cancel any class or event.
 - (b) to divide any class.
 - (c) to alter the advertised times.
 - (d) to refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason.
 - (e) to transfer competitors between sections of a class.
 - (f) to combine classes if less than 3 competitors.
- All competitors to be in full uniform for presentations.
- For the Dressage day Seniors may choose to ride in either Class 3, Class 4 or Class 5 – if not nominated must ride Class 3.
- For Combined Training Seniors choose their height – if not nomination they will ride 80cm.
- All graded horses **must compete at current grading shown on their card.**
- Green horse class is specific to young and green (inexperienced horses).
- **The Unofficial Classes are for inexperienced competitors – experienced competitors please ride HC.**

DISPUTES

Complaints are to be lodged with the Secretary, in writing, accompanied by \$50.00 within 30 minutes of the results being posted.

CAMPING & YARDS

Are available upon request. Camping \$10 per family per night. Camping Fee includes One Horse Yard.

Additional Yards \$5/Horse/Night

As the yards are close to our club house we ask that you clean your yard at the end of the day.

CANTEEN
