HC ruling applies. Competitors may ride two horses only throughout the competition. Riders may have two horses in the same class whereby the HC horse must be ridden second and be stated HC when nominating.

***Seniors:** All of the above classes are open to senior riders. Senior riders will be scored and awarded ribbons separately, according to their placing in that class and points awarded accordingly to determine the overall Senior Award from all eligible classes. If height not stated, Seniors will be placed in 80cm.

This event will be a qualifier for the 2010 State Show Jumping Championships

12yrs & Under riders may ride graded horses, but should only enter on a horse that they normally ride at Pony Club.

Riders in Grades A, B, C, D and Pony & Galloway must be 13 years of age or over & have a performance card.

Ponies or Galloway's must not exceed 15hh. Riders may choose **either** Pony & Galloway or a graded class but may not compete in both at the same fixture. Starting height for Pony & Galloway will be 90cm, maximum 1.10m. If insufficient entries, P & G will be run in conjunction with D Grade, scored on a separate sheet. However P & G must stop at 1.10m.

Riders may enter one competitive horse in an official class and one competitive horse in an unofficial height class OR two horses in the same section, one of which must be ridden H.C. and stated H.C. when nominating. Riders competing in the graded section cannot ride a graded horse in the unofficial section at heights under 80 cm.
