**CLASS G** Seniors can ride in class A to E and will be awarded separate ribbons on the placing in the large group but not take the place of a junior rider – please advise of class/height when nominating.

**AWARDS:-** Ribbons to 5<sup>th</sup> place in each round – points to 10<sup>th</sup> place  
Trophies/Medallions to 3<sup>rd</sup> place overall in each class.

All Classes will consist of an AM5, Power & Speed will be run to Para 74.2.2 and Grand Prix will be run to Para 73.3.1

All of the above classes are open to senior riders except class 5. Senior riders will be scored and awarded separately, according to their placing in that class and points awarded accordingly to determine the overall Senior Award from all 7 eligible classes.

**Height Classes** Riders if they are competing in official classes can not ride a graded horse in class 6(45cm) or class 7 (60cm)  
**12 & Under riders** may ride graded or upgraded horses, but should enter only on a horse that they normally ride at pony club. . No Performance card is required.  
**Riders in Grades A,B,C,D and Pony & Galloway must be 13 yrs of age or over. Ponies or Galloway must not exceed 15hh. Riders may choose either Pony & Galloway or a graded class but may not compete in both at the same fixture. Starting height for Pony & Galloway is 90cm, maximum height 1.1m. .**  
**Riders may enter one competitive horse in Official Program and one competitive horse in the Height Classes OR two horses in the same section, one of which must be ridden H.C.**  
**Showjumping Performance Cards for Grades A,B,C,D, and Pony & Galloway to be presented to Secretary before 8.00am.**

Ribbons to fifth place in each class- points to 10<sup>th</sup> place  
Prizes:- Trophies/medals to 3<sup>rd</sup>
